The Barbara Ann Johnston Preble Memorial Scholarship Application

1. Eligibility: Students of the Scottish performing arts in music, dancing, piping, fiddling, clarsach, drumming, and song, etc. are eligible for grants. Academic or arts and crafts scholarships are not available. All applicants must have a minimum of two years experience in their specialty. Members of the Board of Director and their families are not eligible. Only complete application packets will be considered. Grants may be awarded for two (2) consecutive years. Applicants may reapply following a break of at least one (1) year.
2. Decisions of the scholarship committee will be based on the applicant's objectives, commitment, demonstrated proficiency, anticipated development, and future goals. We give preference to students from Massachusetts.
3. A recommendation by your current teacher is a necessary part of this application. Also include a reference from your previous teacher if you have been studying with the current teacher less than a year. The recommendation should state what the relationship of the sponsor is to the applicant, (i.e. teacher, pipe major, music director, etc.), and the length of time the applicant has studied with the teacher. It should address the applicant's skill level; progress made this year; commitment; demonstrated proficiency; and anticipated development. No application will be considered without a sponsor's letter of recommendation.
4. To give the applicant more control over the application process, we now require the applicant to obtain the letter of recommendation and mail it in the same envelope with his/her application. Your application and letter of recommendation must be post marked no later than April 1, 2008 to be eligible for consideration by this committee.
5. If you wish to be notified of the committee's decision enclose a self addressed stamped envelope with your application.
6. Grants will be sent directly to the school you designate and must be returned if you do not attend.
7. Enclose a photograph of yourself performing.
8. Include a program brochure, if available.
9. Applicants should submit one original application to the address at the top of this application.
